Please also direct your field officers/ seed inspectors to have a constant vigil on the situation and draw sample of all suspicious cotton seeds and send it to the Central Institute of Cotton Research, Nagpur for conformity test so that sale of spurious Bt cotton seed could be checked. Legal action in this matter is to be taken in accordance with the provision of laws under Seed Act-1966, Seed (Control) Order-1983 and Environment (Protection) Act-1986 on the basis of test reports. The field officers should also check the stock position of such seed with the dealers & that bills are given with the name of farmer mentioning other details like lot number etc.

Dear Shri Barwale,

- 1.0 This has reference to your letter no. SBD/622/2005 dated, 27<sup>th</sup> January 2005, regarding the above proposal. The Genetic Engineering Approval Committee (GEAC) set up by this Ministry in accordance with the Rules for Manufacture, Use, Import, Export and Storage of hazardous Microorganisms/Genetically Engineered Organisms or Cells 1989, under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 has considered your request in the meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2005.
- 2.0 After careful and in-depth consideration, of the findings of the large-scale trials and ICAR trials and taking into consideration the recommendation of MEC, RCGM and ICAR, the GEAC accorded approval for commercial cultivation of 6301 Bt and MRC—6304 Bt for the North zone (Rajasthan, Haryana & Punjab).
- 3.0 The commercial release of 6301 Bt and MRC-6304 Bt containing Cry 1Ac gene is subject to the following conditions:
  - The period of validity of approval is for two years i.e. from March 2005 Feb 2007.
  - The applicant should look for the incidence of sucking pests on these hybrids and carry out artificial screening for CLCV resistance and submit its report to the GEAC.
  - The post release monitoring with specific reference to CLCV should be carried out by the State Department of Agriculture through the State Agriculture Universities and results of Kharif 2005 should be placed before the GEAC for further evaluation before the hybrids are taken up for commercial cultivation for the second year (Kharif 2006).
  - iv. Every field where Bt cotton is planted shall be fully surrounded by a belt of land called 'refuge' in which the same non-Bt cotton variety shall be sown. The size of the refuge belt should be such as to take at least five rows of non-Bt cotton or shall be 20% of total sown area whichever is more.
  - v. To facilitate this, each packet of seeds of the approved varieties should also contain a separate packet of the seeds of the same non-Bt cotton variety, which is sufficient for planting in the refuge defined above.
  - vi. Each packet should be appropriately labeled indicating the contents and the description of the Bt hybrid including the name of the transgenes, the GEAC approval reference, physical and genetic purity of the seeds. The packet should also contain detailed directions for use including sowing pattern, pest management, suitability of agro-climatic conditions etc., in vernacular language.

- vii. M/s Mahyco shall enter into agreements with their dealers/agents, that will specify the requirements from dealers/agents to provide details about the sale of seeds, acreage cultivated, and state/regions where Bt cotton is sown.
- viii. M/s Mahyco shall prepare annual reports by 31<sup>st</sup> March each year on the use of Bt cotton hybrid varieties by dealers, acreage, locality (state and region) and submit the same in electronic form to GEAC.
- ix. M/s Mahyco shall develop plans for Bt based 'Integrated Pest Management' and include this information in the seed packet.
- x. M/s Mahyco shall monitor annually the susceptibility of bollworms to Bt gene vis-à-vis baseline susceptibility data and submit data relating to resistance development, if any, to THE GEAC.
- xi. Monitoring of susceptibility of bollworms to the Bt gene shall also be undertaken by an agency identified by the Ministry of Environment and Forests at the applicant's cost.
- xii. M/s Mahyco shall undertake an awareness and education programme, interalia through development and distribution of educational material on Bt cotton, for farmers, dealers and others.
- xiii. M/s Mahyco shall also continue to undertake studies on possible impacts on non-target insects and crops, and report back to the GEAC annually.
- xiv. The label on each packet of seeds, and the instruction manual inside the packet should contain all relevant information.
- xv. M/s Mahyco shall deposit 100 g seed each of approved hybrids as well as their parental lines with the National Bureau of Plant Genetic Resources (NBPGR).
- xvi. M/s Mahyco shall develop and deposit with the NBPGR, the DNA fingerprints of the approved varieties.
- xvii. M/s Mahyco shall also provide to the NBPGR, the testing procedures for identifying transgenic traits in the approved varieties by DNA and protein methods.
- 4.0 You are hereby directed to convey to the undersigned within 15 days of receipt of this communication your unequivocal acceptance of the above conditions, failing which, this approval is liable to be revoked.

Sir.

With reference to your D.O. No.2-1/2005-SD-V dated 24th November, 2005 to the Pr. Secretary Agriculture, Govt. of Rajasthan, it is submitted that the desired information vide your department's letters dated 23.6.2005 and 5.9.2005 have already been sent to the Director(Seeds), GOI, vide this office letter No-3398 dated 17.9.2005. A copy of this letter is enclosed for your kind perusal. As far as performance of Bt. Cotton in the State during Kharif-2005 is concerned, it has not performed well in some districts due to high temperature and iong dry spell. This has led to bad opening (early bursting) of balls and reduction in the yield. 3t. Cotton, being a hybrid, requires high fertility and more irrigation as compared to the varieties in the State. In some areas where frequent irrigation facility was available, Bt. Cotton has performed well. There was no CLCV reported either in Bt. or non Bt. Cotton. However, being the first season for Bt. Cotton in our State, overall performance can not be assessed due to adverse-climatic conditions.
